

Rainbow Flying Fish

Paper: any kind of paper works: printing paper, cardboard, magazine, newspaper, one for your drawings, old paper scraps, etc. Pick your favorite or what you have around the house!

A pair of scissors

Crayons or colored pencils or pens

Tape (optional)

- 1. Draw fish scales on a sheet of paper.
- **2.** With the scissors cut paper strips of about 8 "X1" or 20 cm X 2 cm. It doesn't need to be perfect!
- **3.** About half an inch (a bit over a 1 cm) from the top of the strip cut a notch to about half of the width of the strip.
- **4.** Bend the strip of paper and fit the opposite end of the paper through the notch.
- **5.** Make plenty! Then throw your paper fish in the air and watch them spin as they come down.
